ANSA QLD TAG ALLOCATION POLICY PER CALENDAR YEAR

ANSA QLD's current allocation of tags for clubs is as follows,

- Each club may receive up to 200 T-Bar/gun or 100 dart tags free per calendar year. Dart/spear tags allocation is less due to the increased costs.
- 2. Tags can be ordered as a bulk lot or spread out over the year; it is entirely up to the club's tagging officer.
- 3. If a club needs more than 200 tags ANSA QLD <u>may</u> choose to subsidize up to another 200 tags (200 free + 200 subsidised = 400 tags).
- 4. The current subsidised cost for tags is \$1 dollar per T-Bar tag, or \$2 for dart/spear tags with ANSA QLD covering the difference.
- Any further assistance with supplying tags will be entirely at the discretion of ANSA QLD, and based on written submission from individual clubs, otherwise any further tags will be supplied at full cost recovery.
- 6. When considering any tag allocation ANSA QLD will review and take into considerations the following,
 - The goals of the clubs monitoring plan (if applicable) and progress made towards these goals
 - The number of tags previously received by the club
 - The number of tags used by the club
 - The number of active taggers within the club
 - The primary reason for the request for a tag allocation
